# AN AUTUMN STATEMENT FOR A FAILING **GOVERNMENT**

The King's Speech was notable for being the first by a King for 73 years. Unfortunately the content did not reflect the challenges real people are facing. The Festive Season is a time when the demands on the household budget are at their greatest - high energy bills, rising rents with presents to be bought, travel costs associated with family get togethers. The hard truth is that under the Tories disposable income will have risen by £42 pounds over 14 years. The price of food has gone up 29% this parliament (comparing December 2019 with October 2023). Over the 13 years of the last Labour Government, disposable income rose £10,000. The tax burden is at its highest since 1947 but what are we paying for - not for better services that is clear. The Tories have presided poorer and public services are broken.

Despite this for his 'Autumn Statement' the has jurisdiction over Israel and Gaza. Chancellor chose to pretend everything in the garden was rosy - but the Tory garden doesn't look anything like life in Newcastle right now.

He said he was cutting taxes - when he was just handing back £1 for every £8 the Tories have taken. He also announced some investment for the automotive sector but not on the scale needing to deliver good jobs here in Newcastle. The Autumn Statement showed just how out of touch and out of ideas the Government is.

The suffering in the Gaza Strip is unimaginable. I was deeply distressed that the humanitarian pause - which included a suspension of the bombing, hostage release and humanitarian aid - ended and that hostilities and therefore horrendous suffering has resumed. We need to do everything we can to move towards a cessation of hostilities and a renewed peace over a lost decade where people have got process. Labour is proposing a Middle East Peace Envoy to drive this forward. We also need to be clear that the International Criminal Court
