I brought my Ten Minute Rule Bill to Parliament on the hidden epidemic of bowel disease in the North East. I was grateful to the Bowel disease sufferers who shared their stories of living with stomas and helped give the debate on the Bill great impact. I was touched by the many emails and letters I received from stoma users across the country. We need to be able to measure and assess the rate of bowel disease in order to provide the right support to sufferers. Ten Minute Rule Bills almost never make it into law, but they can be used effectively to raise issues.

I was angered by the circus of Conservative chaos following the disastrous Mini Budget when the then Prime Minister Liz Truss refused to be accountable for the economic chaos she was causing and the leader of the House Penny Mordant claimed she was showing 'courage' by sacking her Chancellor and told. I told the House that the PM was arrogant, desperate and opportunistic.

I continue to engage with the Prime Minister, Ministers, Government Agencies and others regarding the situation in Iran, planning issues, local bus services and the issues facing constituents who use them, and issues surrounding the home schooling of children.
