

# NEWCASTLE DESERVES BETTER THAN BORIS JOHNSON

Over the Jubilee Weekend many were able to relax with family and friends as well as joining in one of the many celebrations of the Queen's Jubilee. Across Newcastle Central, residents reflected on the Queen's 70-year commitment to public service.

It was a real contrast then to see on our return to Parliament that the Tories were still standing by Boris Johnson, whose values and behaviours are so at odds with the interests and the spirit of our country and our region. Yes, 141 of them voted that they have no confidence in him, but that was not enough to convince him to leave office. So many Tories, and his entire cabinet, don't have the backbone to act in the National Interest. We have an out of touch Prime Minister and a Conservative Party too caught up in their internal infighting to do their duty by the country.

The Queen's Speech was also a massive disappointment - more notable for what was not in it than what was in it. As I said in my speech in Parliament, there was no emergency budget, no employment Bill, no plan for growth. I am pleased that the Conservatives did finally accept Labour's call for a windfall tax to help people facing this unprecedented cost of living crisis, but of course they did it in such a way that energy companies are incentivised to invest more in oil and gas. That won't deliver the sustainable, secure, green energy we so desperately need.
