The enclosed letter gives summaries of the ordeals suffered by two of my constituents who were with me on a visit to Israel and Palestine last week. We observed a peaceful protest against the separation barrier near the village of Bil'in in the West Bank.

I am very concerned at their treatment during the protest as well as the religious and racial profiling that seemed to occur on our entrance to and exit from Israel.

I hope you will take up my concerns with the Israeli government and will you also let me know if you have received any other complaints of a similar nature.

On a positive note, I would like to extend my thanks to the British Embassy in Tel Aviv who were extremely helpful during Councillor Ahad's detention as well as the British Consulate General in Jerusalem who took the time to meet with us and brief us.

Would you be willing to meet with me and Councillor Ahad and Councillor Stockdale to discuss the ongoing human rights issues highlighted within the enclosed letter?
